English

Maths

- Select a city in the Amazon Basin region, for example Manaus and research information to put in a table – hours of sunshine /temperature/rainfall. You could then compare with a city near us.
- Find as many 2D and 3D shapes in your home as well as acute, right angle, obtuse and reflex angles. Draw or include a picture of these in your book and label

Science

- Create a video in the style of David Attenborough, using living things found in and around your home.
- Dissect the parts of a plant – what is each part used for? Produce a diagram or model of this plant and label with information
