

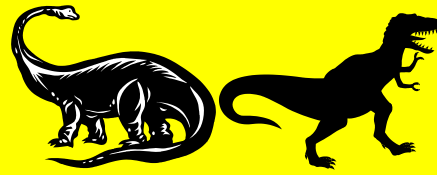
English
