English

- Research a famous earthquake and write a diary entry as if you were a survivor.
- Read a range of folk tales and fairy tales. Which is your favourite? Why?
- Create some of your own poems with a structure (E.g. shape poems/calligrams) and decorate them.

This year, we are giving you a menu of homework activities to complete over a full term. We have listened to feedback and understand that this will give pupils more freedom to choose which of the activities to complete over a higher number of weeks. Over the next term, you must complete as many of the activities as you can, but at the very least you must choose 1 of the English and Maths activities, and also choose at least 3 others to complete. As we are giving you a lot of time to complete this homework, we expect good quality work. All subjects will also be covered in school at some point over the term.

PSHCE

- Make a list/create a picture of what makes you happy.



Physical Education

- Practise your throwing and catching skills.

RE

- Draw or create a model of a scene from the Nativity.

Music

- Make an instrument that has a low or high pitch.

Spanish

- Have a basic conversation in Spanish (Hello, your name, your age etc)

Maths

- Choose a multiplication table that you have not yet learnt. Write it down and practise - don't forget the corresponding division facts!
- Create your own addition and subtraction questions by rolling dice to make the numbers. Try to extend yourself by using 3-digit numbers.

Geography

- Locate, describe and explain why so many earthquakes and volcanoes occur around the Pacific Ring of Fire.

History

- Draw/make some Stone Age artefacts.

Art

- Make up your own story, it can be about anything you like but tell it through cave art pictures!

Design Technology

- Design an earthquake proof building for a famous Burnley structure (E.g. Turf Moor)

Science

- Be a soil detective: With an adult, look at the soil in your garden or local area. Is it different to the soil from our garden? Draw a soil cocktail to show what you have found.
- Draw fossils and label with information.
- Research famous Palaeontologists.
