There is a Hero in All of Us!



English

Our English links with our History topic and we will be studying 'Stig of the Dump' by Clive King. After analysing the structure of the story, we will write our own variation. As a link to our Geography topic, we will write diary entries from the perspective of people who experienced the 2011 Christchurch earthquake in New Zealand. After half term, we will read a range of folk tales and write our own linked to our History topic. We will then immerse ourselves in explanation texts and write our own about earthquakes and volcanoes. As Christmas approaches, we will move onto poems with a structure.

Science

As well as developing key skills in Science, we will also make a link to our History and Geography topics by studying 'Rocks.' We will discover the different types of rocks and how they are formed. We will also compare, and group rocks based on appearance and properties as well as investigating the permeability of different types of soil.

We will learn about how to stay safe online. This will include how to protect ourselves against online manipulation and to understand when something online doesn't feel right.

Maths

This half term will be learning the place value of numbers up to 1000. We will also identify the value of each digit in a number and link this to money. We will then move on to adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing efficiently, using mental and written methods. We will focus on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables as well as their corresponding division facts. We will also apply the methods learned to word and reasoning problems.

Geography

We will be investigating the following question: Why do some earthquakes cause more damage than others?

History

How did the lives of Ancient Britons change during the Stone Age? As part of this unit we will be visiting Liverpool World Museum.

Art

We will be studying the artwork of British artist Howard Hodgkin and making printing blocks to create our own artwork in the style of him.

Design Technology

We will plan, design and make earthquake proof buildings linked to our Geography topic.
