## Welcome pack

Dear Parent/Carers

Welcome to Year 6. My name is Mrs Staples and I am your child's class teacher. I have put together this pack which will include lots of information about the coming year. Year 6 is an extremely important year for your children, there is a huge amount of learning that takes place and I feel it is important that we all work together to support them.

In this pack you will find a copy of the Long-Term Plan, the topic web for the Autumn term, various letters, the homework grid and a guide to supporting your children with revision at home.

Below is some information that you might find useful.

## Homework

The homework grid will be continued this year and will last a whole term. As the children have revision to complete at home, year 6 children will be asked to complete revision as well as the homework grid activities. Because of this, the homework grid for year 6 has been modified to allow time for revision. Revision will be sent home when required, for example, when a child has struggled with an area and needs more practise. As well as this, there will be fortnightly spellings for children to learn.

## PE

Our PE lessons will take place on a Monday and a Wednesday. It is essential that your child has the full PE kit on their peg everyday (in case there is a timetable change!)

## Trips

We are planning a year full of different experiences for the children. We will be asking for a contribution for trips outside of school. Any reward trips will have to be fully funded by parents and through fundraising.

## SATs

The SATs tests will take place from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May to Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2019. It is essential that your child is in school for that week. The children will complete 6 test papers over the course of the week. There is no longer a writing SATs paper, this has been replaced by in class writing. This is still assessed and will be moderated by an official marker and therefore the 'writing SATs' as such begin from September.
