Look out for letters coming home after the February half-term with the details of all Clubs that will be running after school.



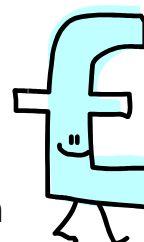
SCHOOL MEALS

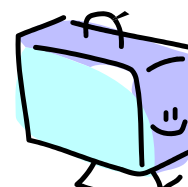
ADDRESS/TELEPHONE CHANGES

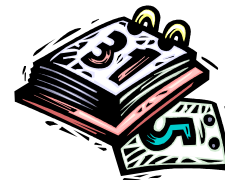
HEADLICE
