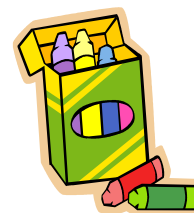


October. These can include tinned and dried goods; biscuits and toiletries, thank you for your continued support. We will be donating the harvest items to St Catherine's Church.
