Dear Parents/Carers,

Since the start of the new academic year, all the children have been allowed to come into school on their PE days in their own sportswear. The primary reason for this was to minimise the spread of COVID19. Whilst this approach was a good idea at the time, as time has gone on, we have found that some of the sportswear that children have worn has not always been suitable for lessons. It is for this reason, a decision has been made to issue all children from Y1-6 with a PE kit, which they can wear to school on the day that they have PE - starting in the New Year.

Your child/children will be coming home with a new top of the range PE kit that has been issued by school **free of charge**. The PE kit consists of a dual performance zip hoodie and a tracksuit trouser. Unfortunately (given the expense - £60.00 for both items) we are only able to issue one set. For this reason, could you please ensure your child does not wear this kit outside of their PE days and it is labelled. We will not be able to provide a **free replacement**, if it becomes damaged or they lose any item.

If your child is in Y1-6 and has not come home with a kit, please be assured that they have not been overlooked. We are still awaiting delivery of additional kits; however, this will not be until the first half of the New Year. Until this happens, please could you ensure your child comes to school (in the New Year) in their own sportswear, which is similar in colour and where possible in style (see below) to the kit that has been issued.



Lastly, a quick reminder...

Over the Christmas period, could you all please check that your child has a pair of black school pumps - that fit - which they can wear during their PE lessons. We ask that the pumps are brought into and left in school so that they have access to them at all times. Children will continue to be allowed to wear their own trainers to school **on the day that they have PE** but will **not** be able to wear them during their PE lesson.
