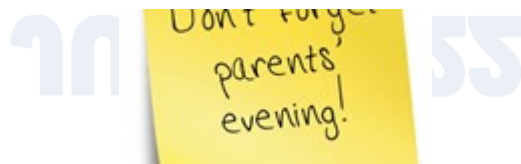

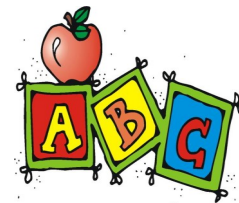
KINGSWOOD TRIP

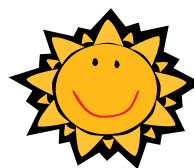
Dates for the other High Schools will be provided later.

School Meals from September 2022

The price of a school meal from September will increase by 5p per day, so the daily rate will be £2.40 and weekly, £12.00.



Y2 Pupils moving to Y3

Please note, if your child is to continue having school meals from September and they are not entitled to Free School Meals, then you will need to pay £12.00 per week. The government funded Universal Free School Meals only apply to EYFS, Y1 & Y2 pupils. If you think you are entitled to FSM then please apply using the link on our website under: Parent Zone/Free School Meal Application



MEAL CHOICES

Meals have now been fixed for the remainder of this term if you wish to move your child from meals to packed lunches or visa versa, then the next change will be from September 2022. *Cost of meals if not eligible for free school meals, is £12.00 per week.*
