We will begin by learning about the theory of evolution and Charles Darwin, we will be learning about animals that have evolved and the reasons for this such as new predators, climate change and new viruses.

We'll be investigating the religion of Islam - Viewing the focus of commitment how the followers of this religion show commitment to their God.
