English

Key text: The Story Tree: Tales to be read aloud.

We will be reading a few stories from The Story Tree, including, The Magic Porridge Pot, Monkey-See, Monkey Do, The Sweetest Song and Little Lord Feather Frock. We will be focusing on listening to, discussing, unpicking characters' emotions and writing our own stories.

Humanities

Enquiry Question: Who is the greatest history maker?

We will be learning about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements and about events beyond our living memory that are significant nationally or globally.



Science

Focus Area: Living things and their habitats

We will begin by learning about living, non-living and dead things and how we can sort them into categories. We will then move on to learning about habitats and what they provide for animals. Additionally, we will focus on food chains, so that we can understand how living things depend on each other and their environment for their survival.

Music

Timbre - Ostinato

The children will internalise the beat in their heads. Learn that timbre describes the character or quality of a sound. Improvise a simple rhythm to create an ostinato (short, repeated pattern).
