Focus Area: We will continue with number bonds and numbers to 10. We will improve our skills in counting forwards and backwards. We will gain a good understanding of the number bonds to 10 and be able to recall them fluently.

Arithmetic Focus: We will focus on addition and subtraction skills. We will use practical equipment and games to help us learn.

Science

Focus Area: Animals including humans We will be continuing with the topic we started last half term. As part of the topic this term we will be looking at how to look after animals and will begin to learn about the human body.

We will be learning to roll a ball with increased accuracy. We will also investigate which part of our body is best to use to roll the ball to a partner.
