English

Key text: Suffragette: The Battle for Equality

This powerful book tells the truly inspirational tale of women's suffrage and the journey to equality, one that is still ongoing. We will learn about significant women whose actions have directly impacted our lives today. Our writing will focus on non-fiction, allowing us to apply the EGPS skills we have developed over the year.

Humanities

Enquiry Question: How have the medical breakthroughs of the last 250 years affected the lives of people in Britain?

This relevant enquiry will take us back in time to life without vaccines, a life in the dark ages and allow us to compare how Britain has changed and how that impacted us during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Enquiry Question: Is Christianity still a strong religion 2000 years after Jesus was on Earth?

We'll investigate the religion of Christianity and discuss our thoughts on whether the religion is still **going strong or** staying to fade in society.

Little Red Riding Hood

The children will develop their language skills using a familiar story from their younger years.

Maths

Focus Area: Algebra, Ration, Position and Movement

This half term will cover translation, coordinates on a four-quadrant grid and begin to introduce algebra allowing us to apply skills from the year so far. We will be using a range of investigations to embed our skills, particularly around coordinates. In addition to this, we will be learning new skills linked to algebra and ratio.

Arithmetic Focus: fractions, percentages, and decimals.

Times Table Focus: 7 and 11

Children on a personalised curriculum will be focusing on shape, space, and measure as well as building on foundation skills.



Focus Area: Animals including Humans

We will be learning all about the human body, the circulation system, and the heart. This will link to the artwork of Davinci and our History enquiry around medical breakthroughs.



The children will continue to develop their skillset in Gymnastics using pieces of equipment like horses, the climbing frame etc. They'll also continue engaging with a programme delivered by a coach.
