English

Key text: The Story Tree: Tales to be read aloud.

We will start the half term by continuing to read 'The Sweetest Song' from The Story Tree. After that, we will move on to read 'Little Lord Feather Frock'. Just before Christmas we will start reading 'Twas the Night Before Christmas'. We will be focusing on discussing, listening to, understanding key vocabulary, and writing our own letters, diary entries and stories. We will take it in turns to share our stories during The Reading Hour.

The Reading Hour: The Enchanted Wood

EGPVS: We will learn about and form nouns using suffixes -ness, -er and by compounding e.g., whiteboard, superman. We will also form adjectives using -ful and -less. Use suffixes -er and -est in adjectives and use -ly to turn adjectives into adverbs e.g. smoothly, softly, bigger, biggest.

Celebrating differences

Art, Craft & DT

Art: Colour

Focus Area: Plants

We will begin by identifying the main parts of plants. We will move on to then learning about the role of the different plant parts and how they are suited to their functions. We will also learn about how plants grow and what plants need to survive.
