Humanities

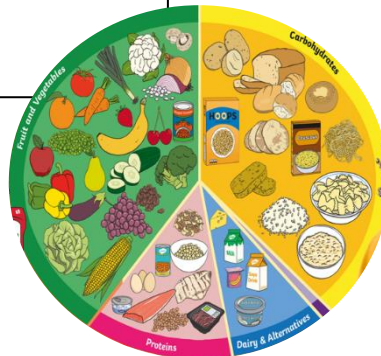
Enquiry Question: What is the geography of where I live?
