



Literacy

We will continue to write simple \overline{CVC} words and begin to explore words with more digraphs in. We will build confidence in how to structure sentences that include capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will look in detail at the story of Errol's Garden and looking at descriptive features. We will read the story of Mr Wolf's Pancakes and make our own lists of ingredients we need.

Maths

We will be looking at addition with numbers up to 10 and then up to 20. We will be identifying the signs used to make an addition number sentence and understand and know our number bonds to 10. We will be learning about capacity and using the vocabulary by practicing this skill in our water area.

Communication and Language

We will learn new vocabulary relating growing. We will know the key vocabulary around planting such as seed, plant, stem, leaves and roots.
