History

Enquiry Question: Why did Elizabeth's Sea dogs make Phillip so angry?

This enquiry sees us learning about one of the world's most powerful monarchs and her quest to be taken seriously amongst the male monarchs across Europe. Queen Elizabeth the first and her fight against Spain will be a focus.



Geography

Enquiry Question: Why does Sylvia have the largest collection of plastic ducks in the world?

This enquiry is linked to one of the biggest crisis' the world is currently experiencing - single-use plastic and the damage it is doing to our Earth, particularly in the ocean.

As we prepare for transition, the children will focus on changes that may happen in their lives. In addition to this, they will take part in a puberty workshop with CORAM.

Enquiry Question: Does belief in Akhirah help Muslims lead good lives? This term we will investigate in depth about the Muslim afterlife and whether Islamic followers believe in this part of life. Does this promise help Muslim lead a good life?
