Learning to play, Playing to learn!



Literacy

We will be continuing to learn new sounds from phase 3 and tricky words in our phonics sessions daily.

We will be applying and practicing this new knowledge in our guided and 1:1 reading and guided writing sessions. Our writing will also link in with other areas of the curriculum too.

Maths

We will be further developing our ability to subitise and our understanding of the composition of numbers to 10 - knowing number bonds to 10, including doubles. We will also start to look at odds and evens and halving. Learning around this will involve lots of hands-on practical work.

Communication and Language

We will learn new vocabulary relating to the core books we are reading - The Train Ride and Handa's Surprise. As well as linking some of our learning to Non-fiction books. The children will then apply their newly acquired vocabulary through play in provision.

Miss Wilson will continue to deliver targeted language support using the NELI and WELCOMM programmes.
