Comprehension, Word Reading, and Writing

We will be continuing to learn new sounds from phase 3 and tricky words in our phonics sessions daily. We will be applying and practicing this new knowledge in our guided and 1:1 reading and guided writing sessions. The children will then apply their phonics when writing sentences which they will link to other areas of the curriculum and continuous provision.

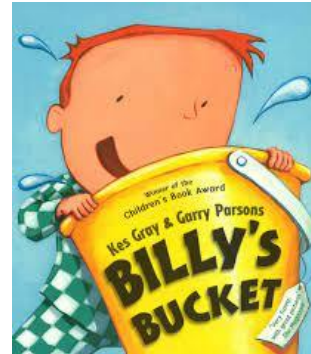
Number and Numerical Patterns

We will be further developing our ability to subitise as well as further developing our understanding of the composition of numbers beyond 20. Additionally, we will focus on our number bonds to 10, including doubles. Lastly, we will focus on telling the time on a digital clock.

Communication and Language

We will learn new vocabulary relating the core books we are reading - On Sudden Hill and Billy's Bucket. As well as linked Non-fiction books. We will apply our new vocabulary through play in provision.

Miss Wilson will continue to deliver targeted language support using the NELI and WELCOMM programmes.



Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be focusing on developing in our Jigsaw sessions. In RE we will be looking at stories from different religions with a focus on special people.

Gross Motor Skills and Fine Motor Skills

We will be doing our fundamental skills every day for an hour, this is where we will practice: running, jumping, hopping, skipping, and catching.

For fine motor skills the children will focus on precision and hand- eye coordination. As part of this we will continue to focus on letter and number formation, whilst also using scissors to cut different media, paint and mark make.



Past and Present

We will be looking at similarities and differences between things in the past and present. Linking in with our core books and non-fiction books.

People, Culture and Communities

We will be exploring different cultures across the World as well as focusing on communities within. Additionally, we will be focusing on the work of David Attenborough and the contribution he has made on a global level.

Creating with Materials and Being Imaginative

We will continue to see, learn, and explore different dance styles. In Music we will be exploring different instruments and composition.

In our Art lessons we will be focusing on junk modelling, and box crafting.
