Enquiry Questions:


What happened to the boy behind the golden mask? How do volcanoes affect the lives of people on Heimaey?

RE

Enquiry Question: Do beliefs in Karma, Samsara and Moksha help Hindus lead good lives?

The children will learn about Karma, and how the natural law of Karma is created and balanced in the universe. Additionally, they will learn about Samsara-reincarnation and how this is governed by how karma is created and balanced. Lastly, they will touch upon Moksha and how this is liberation from the cycle of Samsara. The children will then consider how all three impact Hindu's decision making through life.







Science

Focus Area: Living things and their habitats.

The children will undertake learning linked to the life cycles of plants and animals. Additionally, they will recap their understanding of what a habitat is before looking at how animals and plants are adapted to their environments.
