History and Geography

Enquiry Question: History - How do artefacts help us understand the lives of people in Iron Age Britain? The children will be interpreting a range of evidence to identify and describe common features of the archaeological remains of Iron Age Hill Forts, Iron Age Roundhouse and what these suggested about the lives of the people during this time.

Enquiry Question: Geography - Why do so many people in the world live in megacities?

The children will have the opportunity to observe and describe key features of cities and suggest reasons for such high density. They will also explain the distribution of megacities. Additionally, they will also identify, describe and explain some of the main geographical features of one of the top 40 megacities in the world.

Music

We will be looking at a wide range of instruments and orchestral music.

PSHCE Valuing Difference

We will be looking at how we are different to others and why that is good.

Maths

Focus Area: Addition and subtractions including large numbers of 3-digits using the column method.

Arithmetic Focus: Number bonds to 100

Times Table Focus: 4 and 8 times table

Science

Focus Area: Rocks and Soils

We will be learning about and investigating rocks including sedimentary, igneous, metamorphic rock and learning what fossils are and how they are made. We will also look at the work of Mary Anning and how her discoveries contributed to our understanding of dinosaurs.
