Times Table Focus: 2s, 5s and 10s

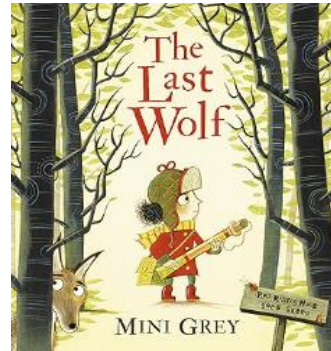
History and Geography

Enquiry Question: How do we know so much about what happened in the Great Fire of London?

We will be endeavouring to find the main effects of the Great Fire of London in 1666 on the city and its people.

Enquiry Question: How can we persuade people to join us in tackling the causes of global warming?

We will be identifying the main fossil fuels and explaining what they are used for in the UK.



Science

Focus Area: Use of Everyday Materials

The children will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting, and stretching. The children will also learn more about science in real life through looking at the work of a Material Scientist- Pearl Agyakwa.

RE

Enquiry Question:

How important is it for Jewish people to do what God asks them to do?

PE

Focus Area: Dance

The children will work as individuals, pairs, small groups and a class to convey a story through movement using travel, jump, turn, gesture and stillness.

Music

Composing and Improvising

The children will be creating rhythms using word phrases and inventing some of their own. They will also be composing a response to a non-musical stimulus.

PSHCE

Focus: Keeping Myself Safe

We're thinking the different ways we can keep ourselves healthy and safe, including staying safe online. We'll also be learning skills to help us look after our body.

Art, Craft & DT

Focus: Clay Houses

The children will be working with clay. As part of their learning they will be fattening, smoothing and rolling clay to create tiles.

Computing

Focus: E-Safety

The children will be learning about personal information and how they can keep themselves safe on the internet.
