### London Trip

We are pleased to inform you that we have organised an educational trip to the Tower of London from Thursday 7th to Friday 8th March 2024.

The trip will commence on Thursday 7th March and the children should be 'dropped-off' at Burnley Manchester Road Train station arriving promptly **at 8:30 in the morning** as we do not want them to 'miss' the train.

We will return to Burnley Manchester Road Station on **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 4.00pm** where you should be waiting to collect your child, thank you.

During their visit to the Tower of London, the children will have the opportunity to take part in a Pirate Prisoners Workshop. This workshop has been designed to engage the students in an interactive and immersive learning experience, where they will discover the living conditions and experiences of prisoners during the pirate era. We believe that this workshop will provide a unique and memorable educational opportunity for our students.

On Friday 8th March, we have arranged a visit to the Houses of Parliament. The purpose of this excursion is to deepen the children's understanding of the British political system and promote active citizenship. The children will have the chance to explore the historic building and witness democracy in action.

We understand that you may have concerns regarding the safety and supervision of your child during this trip. Rest assured that the school staff, along with qualified tour guides, will be present throughout the entirety of the journey. Our priority is the well-being and security of our students, and we will take every precaution necessary to ensure their safety.

The cost of the trip is £50.00 per child, which includes their bed and board. We kindly request that you return the permission slip by Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> February and make payment in full by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March. This will allow us to make the necessary arrangements and secure a smooth journey for everyone involved.

Once we have confirmed numbers for the trip, we will send out guidance for what the children will need to bring with them.
