English

Key text: The Tin Forest

A lonely man lives by himself in a junk yard, dreaming of a tropical jungle and wild animals. One day an idea comes to him. Will it change his life?

The Reading Hour: Bright Sparks

EGPVS: Apostrophes, conjunctions, and prepositions.

Maths

Focus Area: Multiplying and dividing by 3, 4 and 8 including word problems.

Arithmetic Focus: Counting in jumps of 3, 4 and 8.

Times Table Focus: 3, 4 and 8.

History and Geography

Enquiry Question: How did the arrival of the Romans change Britain?

Enquiry Question: Why are jungles so wet and deserts so dry?



Science

Focus Area: Forces and Magnets

We will be looking at forces this term. We will look at what types of forces there are, how friction affects motion, and investigate materials using magnets. We will think about what questions we want to investigate and how to conduct fair tests.

RE

Enquiry Question: Could Jesus heal people? Were these miracles or is there some other explanation?

The children will understand what a miracle is and explain a Christian viewpoint about one of Jesus' healing miracles.

PE

In PE we will be looking at the skills involved in cricket including striking and fielding. We will also be creating dances with the theme of superheroes, which will also involve focusing on character skills.

Spanish

We will learn the names of 10 fruits in Spanish and be introduced to the simple opinions 'I like' and 'I do not like'. The text we will be focusing on will be, 'A song of Frutas' by Ferran Adrià.

Music

Focus: Composing and improvising

We will be learning how to create basic 3 note tunes and simple rhythms using crotchets, quavers, minims and their rests.

PSHCE

This term we will be looking at how we can keep ourselves safe on the road and around strangers. The children will also be identifying risks and dangers of smoking and alcohol.

Art, Craft & DT

In art we will be creating various 3D structures and think about how to join pieces together. They will be developing their ideas from 3D artwork and apply their knowledge to their own 3D structure.

Computing

The children will use technology safely, respectfully, and responsibly, recognising acceptable/unacceptable behaviour. They will also be identifying a range of ways to report concerns about content and contact.
