Fractions and Decimals- Adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators, converting between fractions and decimals.


Arithmetic Focus: Fractions and decimals

Science

Focus Area: We will be comparing the properties of different materials, changing states of matter, and looking at reversible and irreversible changes. As part of the topic the children will also be introduced to scientists within the field of science that they are studying.

RE

Enquiry Question: How can Brahman be everywhere and in everything? The children will be making links between Hindu beliefs regarding Brahman and Gods in relation to how they choose to live their lives. From this the children will then express their understanding of how Brahman can/cannot be in everything.

PE

This half-term the children will be conducting a unit of learning all about Dance which links to the Highway Man. In addition to this, the children will be developing their skills in relation to Invasion Games- Netball. This will involve further refining their passing and catching skills so that they are able to demonstrate greater accuracy and control.

Spanish

Focus: At the café.
The children will be learning how to order different food and drink at the café.

Music

Focus: Composing and Improvising.
