Times Table Focus: all times tables

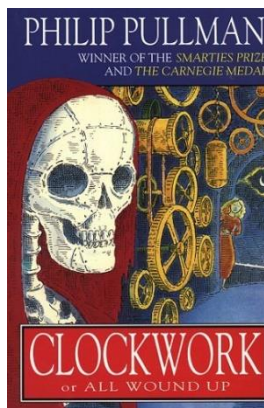
History and Geography

Enquiry Question: Why did Britain once rule the largest empire the world has ever seen?

The children will identify and describe the extent of the British Empire in 1921 and explain what it meant to be a colony. They will then describe and explain the main reasons why Britain wanted an empire and evaluate and justify their choice of those factors that they consider were most significant.

Enquiry Question: How is Climate Change Affecting the World?

The children will be looking to explain how changing patterns of weather at different locations around the world impact lives. In addition, they will look at global warming.



Science

Focus Area: Living things and their habitats.

The children will be classifying living things according to common observable characteristics and based on their similarities and differences. In our scientist study work, the children will be looking at the work of Libbie Hyman, who is a Zoologist and also how Dr Ben Woodcock has contributed to science in his work as an Ecological Entomologist.

Striking and fielding/ athletics

The children will be performing running techniques for short and long distances as well as developing running for speed. Finally, they will also be developing and further refining their throws.

Enquiry Question: Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives? The children will be learning that the concept of Jihad can be interpreted differently leading to different actions and consequences.
