English

Key text: Where the Wild Things Are

The children will take part in lots of learning linked to this book. The children will write character and setting descriptions, compose music and poems and produce their own story.

EGPVS: Forming a few sentences which include Verbs and descriptive language.

Phonics Focus: We will be consolidating our previous learning and including phase 5 sounds such as are, tch, oe and ph.

Maths

Focus Area: Shape, Space and Measure

We will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes, as well as patterns. We will then proceed to compare height and lengths of items.

Arithmetic Focus:

We will be solving mathematical problems using addition, subtraction, and number bonds.

History and Geography

Enquiry Question:

Why was Charles sent to prison?

Enquiry Question:

Where in the world is home for Denise and how does it compare with where I live?



Science

Focus Area: Plants

We will begin to learn about common, wild, and garden plants including how plants grow. Additionally, the children will start to focus on the basic structure of common flowering plants in more detail, as well as focusing on key skills within scientific enquiry.

RE

Enquiry Question: Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?

We will be learning about the religion of Judaism. We will be focusing on Shabbat and its importance for Jewish Children, Additionally, we will explore places of worship within the Jewish faith.



PE

The children will learn the foundation to athletics such as running over different distances and obstacles and passing an implement. They will also be enhancing their gross motor skills to help with throwing and jumping.

Music

Focus: Performing and singing

We will be focusing on foundational skills such as basic vocal techniques, pitch, rhythm, and performance skills.

PSHCE

Focus: Being My Best

We will be exploring how to maintain both physical and mental well-being to reach our fullest potential. Additionally, we will discover the positive impacts of praise on our overall development.

Art, Craft & DT

Focus: Nutrition and Sculpture

The children will learn about nutrition, highlighting the importance in maintaining a balanced diet. We will develop skills in creating 3D sculptures enhancing their understanding of form and construction.

Computing

Focus: Programming

The children will begin to learn about what algorithms are and how they are implemented as programs on digital devices.
