



# Hobbits Summer Term 2 2024

## Stronger, Together!



### English

**Key text:** Twitch - a mystery adventure story starring a birdwatching detective called Twitch, who arrives at his hideout to find the wooded area filled with police on the hunt for a missing convict. Throughout this book, children will be empathising, exploring how the author creates characters, writing a balanced argument, developing responses through storytelling, and writing in role.

**EGPS:** Parenthesis, commas to avoid ambiguity

### Maths

**Focus Area:** Area and Perimeter, volume

Calculating the area and perimeter of rectilinear shapes. Using our knowledge of times tables and cube numbers to calculate the volume of cubes and cuboids.

**Arithmetic Focus:** 4 operations, calculating with fractions and decimals

**Times Table Focus:** being fluent in all related division facts up to 12x12.

### History and Geography

**Enquiry Question:** The Trojan Horse - historical fact, legend or myth? We will continue to study sources to come to a conclusion answering this question.

**Enquiry Question:** Where is the most valuable thing in the world and who owns it? We will continue to look at rainfall and use maps to identify the best place for a reservoir.



### Science

**Focus Area:** Living things and their habitats, animals including humans.

The children will learn about the life cycles of plants and animals, and the stages that they go through.

### RE

**Enquiry Question:** What is the best way for a Christian to show commitment to God? The focus of the topic will involve children recognising and understanding what is meant by the term 'commitment' and how they demonstrate this on a day-to-day basis on a personal level. Following this, discussions will focus on how Christians show commitment to God through their religious practices and the reasons why they do so.

### PE

**Orienteering and outdoor adventurous activities**

The children will be participating in learning associated with orienteering. They will also be partaking in numerous problem solving activities that aim to improve their team work skills.

### Spanish

We will be continuing our learning around Goldilocks and the three bears, aiming to be able to retell the story in Spanish.

### Music

We will be analysing and comparing pieces of music, alongside rehearsing for the Lancashire Sing and our Grease production.

### PSHCE

We will be learning about growing and changing, considering how we view ourselves and starting to think about changes through puberty.

### Art, Craft & DT

We will be working towards designing and making a small soft toy which will involve enhancing our sewing skills.

The children will be using iLearn2 to create their own Ebook.
