Spring Forest Tool Talk Procedure

The use of hand tools aids in the development of gross motor skills while bolstering pupil confidence in their growing abilities. It is important that children understand the correct way to use them.

Safety

The Forest School Leader (FSL) will give a safety talk before children use a tool. They will use the acronym below to deliver the safety talk.

P - Parts of the tool.

U - Usage - what the tool is used for.

M - Movement - how it works.

P - Pass the tool to someone.

S - Where and how to store it close to you or storing it away after use.
