English

In each unit we will be developing our reading skills using VIPERS so that we can then write effectively linked to the texts. Our written outcomes include - instructions, fables, slogans, letters, product description and advertisements.

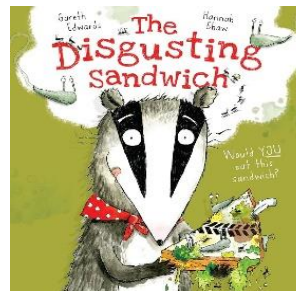
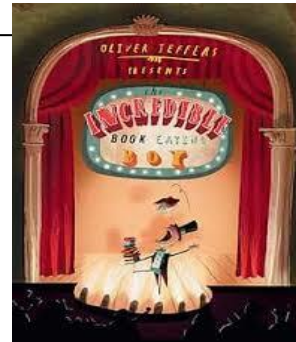
History and Geography

Enquiry Question: Why did Delia buy a new hat?

We will continue to learn about what life was like for passengers on board the Titanic and what happened to Titanic and what changes took place because of the tragedy.

Enquiry Question: Where does our food come from and why does it matter?

The children will describe and explain some of the benefits of buying fruit and vegetables from local farmers. They will also explore what is meant by 'free range' and the benefits this has.



RE

Enquiry Question: Why do Christians say that Jesus is the 'light of the world?' We will be discussing how we use light and explore how it is used in Advent.

Music

Performing and Singing
Children will be singing simple songs in rounds, will join in sections of a longer song. Finally use body percussion.

PSHCE

We will be focusing on Valuing Difference. In order to do this, we will discuss special people in our lives and how we can make others feel.

Maths

Addition and Subtraction - we will continue to build our understanding of addition and subtraction using part-whole models, base 10 equipment and number lines.

2D and 3D Shape - Identify and make 2D shapes and identify and name 3D shapes.

Counting and multiplication - we will start learning our times tables using arrays.

Statistics - Interpret tables and graphs, create tally charts.

Fractions - Halves and quarters

Measure (time, money, capacity and volume) - measure and record capacity, read millilitres and litres, o'clock, half past and quarter past, know coins and add amounts.

Science

Focus Area: Animals including humans

This topic will continue for the children. They will learn about how exercise changes the body. They will then describe and explain why exercise and eating the right amounts of different types of food is important. Following this they will understand what is meant by hygiene.

PE

In PE, we will be focusing on rolling a ball. We will be rolling different equipment with some accuracy and then attempt to use tactics in a rolling game.

Art, Craft & DT

In Art this half term the topic is called Life in Colour.

The children will develop their knowledge of colour mixing and learn how texture can be created with paint.

Computing

The children will learn what makes up a computer, spot digital technology in school and understand how different technology helps us. Additionally, they will focus on data handling.
