English

Maths

Focus Area: Place Value and Addition & Subtraction This half term will focus on numbers up to 10,000 - identifying number values, comparing, sequencing, ordering and rounding numbers.

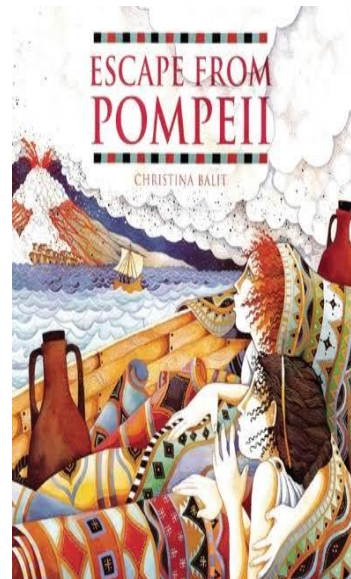
Arithmetic Focus: Addition & Subtraction This will include making links between numbers, number bonds, one more, one less and how we can use this to subtract more effectively.

Times Table Focus: Securing the 2, 5 and 10 times table. Learning the 4 and 8 times table.

History and Geography

Enquiry Question: How did the arrival of the Romans change Britain? We will start by looking at when the Romans arrived and why they migrated to Britain in 43AD. Other themes we look at include significant individuals and advancement and progress.

Enquiry Question: Why is Fairtrade fair? The concept of importing and exporting commodities will be explored initially. Moving on from this, children will explore fair trade.



Science

Focus Area: This half term we are focusing on Animals including Humans. We will be learning about the parts of the human digestive system and how it works as well as what food chains and food webs are. We will also be learning about how to look after our teeth, what can cause tooth decay.

RE

Enquiry Question: What can a Hindu learn through celebrating Diwali?

PE

This term we will be looking at athletics skills. We will also be brushing up on our throwing, catching and racquet skills as well as creating our own games involving balls and racquets.

Spanish

We will be learning how to talk about ourselves and others in Spanish. Additionally, we will be listening to and learning a variety of songs.

Music

For our music we will be learning about a wider range of musical instruments and the sounds they make.
