English

Key text: *The Night Bus Hero* follows Hector, a boy who starts as a bully but learns valuable lessons about kindness and empathy after meeting a homeless man.

The Reading Hour: States of Matter - we are going to be looking at a wide range of texts about the different states of matter.

Maths

Focus Area: Place value, Multiplication, Division, Addition and Subtraction and Fractions.

Arithmetic Focus: Addition & Subtraction. This will include making links between numbers, number bonds, one more, one less and how we can use this to subtract more effectively.

Times Table Focus: We are going to be securing our learning on 3's, 6's and 9's timetables.

History and Geography

Enquiry Question: How is Climate Change affecting the world? We will explore the causes, effects, and solutions to climate change through enquiry-based activities, fostering understanding and action on this global issue.

Enquiry Question: Who were the Anglo-Saxons and how do we know what was important to them?

Children will investigate the people, culture and society in which Anglo-Saxons lived, where they migrated from and how and why they converted to Christianity



Science

Focus Area: States of Matter.

Children learn about the three states of matter (solid, liquid, and gas), their properties, how materials change between states (e.g., melting and freezing), and how temperature affects these changes.



RE

Enquiry Question: How do Sikhs express their beliefs and values?

Children will explore Sikh beliefs, practices, and stories, including the life of Guru Nanak and equality in Sikhism.

PE

Swimming and Rugby.

We will be going swimming in this spring term, on every Tuesday afternoon. Additionally, we will be learning about basic rugby skills, including passing, tackling, and teamwork.
