## **English**

**Key text:** This half term we will focus on developing our ideas through discussion and making connections between the stories and our experiences.

**Phonics Focus:** We will be consolidating Phase 4 and Phase 5 sounds, ay, ou, ie, ea and oy. We will be learning the ue, ew, wh and o sounds.


## History and Geography

# Enquiry Question: How Did People Enjoy Themselves at London Frost Fairs?

We will continue learning about how what a frost fair was, what sort of activities took place on the ice. The children will also be introduced to Charles II when they learn about his guest appearance at the Frost Fair of 1684. Lastly, they will learn why Frost Fairs came to an end.

# Enquiry Question: Where in the world is home for Denise and how does it compare with where I live?

We will continue learning about the human and physical features of St Lucia and in particular Soufriere and how it compares to where we live.





#### Maths

**Focus Area:** we will be continuing to orally count in order, and recall our number bonds to 10 fluently, we will be focusing on our number formation as well as comparing numbers.

**Arithmetic Focus:** We will be learning about sequencing, fractions, capacity and volume, money and time. We will be consolidating our number facts.

#### Science

## Focus Area: Everyday Materials

The children will be identifying everyday materials, describing their properties, as well as distinguishing objects from materials. We will also compare materials during experiments. We will also learn about Ole Kirk Christiansen (Lego Inventor).

#### PΕ

The children will be learning to roll a ball with increased accuracy. They will also investigate which part of their body is best to use to roll the ball to a partner. Finally, they will apply these tactics in a game situation.
