There is a Hero in all of Us!



English

Key text: The Stone Age Boy

We will be exploring the story of a boy who travels through time to the Stone Age and what he experiences and learns while he is there.

The Reading Hour: We will be looking at a range of non-fiction texts that look talk about different deserts linking with our geography.

EGPVS: We will be looking at different types of sentences and how we can improve tese with expanded noun phrases and time conjunctions.

Maths

Focus Area: We will be focusing on 3-digit numbers, thinking out their place value, how to add and subtract from then and use them in calculating length and perimeter.

Arithmetic Focus: Adding and subtraction 10s and 100s in 3-digit numbers and mental addition and subtraction of 2-digit numbers.

Times Table Focus: 2s, 5s and 10s

History and Geography

Enquiry Question: How did the lives of Ancient Britons change during the Stone Age? - We will be exploring what life was like for Stone Age people at the beginning of the Stone Age and how it changed over time.

Enquiry Question: Why are jungles so wet and deserts so dry? - We will be exploring climates around the world.



Science

Focus Area: Animals including Humans.

We will be looking at what a balanced diet is and what nutrients we need to keep out bodies healthy. We will also be looking our bodies and what jobs our muscles and bones do as well as how x-rays can help us look at our bones. As part of this we will be looking at the life of Marie Curie.

RE

Enquiry Question: How (and why) have some people served God? - We will be looking at why Christians choose to follow and serve God as well as thinking about who inspires us in our own lives.

PE

For this term we will be looking at improving out fundamental skills using playground games from the 1950s, 60, 70s and 80s. This will include our running, dodging, throwing and hopping skills as well as thinking about strategy and team work in competitive games.

Spanish

In Spanish we will be learning how to great someone and ask them basic questions about how they are feeling and what their name is.

Music

In music we will be practicing active listening when enjoying music as well as rehearsing our songs for the Harvest festival service.

PSHCE

This term we will be looking at 'Me and My Relationships' with a focus on how we can repair a friendship when we fall out.

Art, Craft & DT

We will be linking our art with our history and English by learning how Stone Age man made paint for cave paintings and creating our own.

Computing

In computing we will be learning how to create digital art and how to produce an effective digital comic strip.
